The Role of Families:

We believe that Parents & Guardians are the first teachers of their children in the ways of faith, particularly by the witness of their lives. Parents are also the best teachers of their children and they are the ones who shape the attitudes and values of their children and their involvement in sacramental preparation can never be replaced.

At Our Lady of Mt Carmel Parish, we are here to assist you as you do your best as Christian parents. The keyword is “assist”, we are not taking over your responsibility as parents. ***As such, it is essential that at least one parent/ guardian accompany their child to each of the sessions of the sacramental preparation process.***

The Role of the Parish:

A Christian family lives within a wider parish community, which also has the responsibility to share and nurture the faith within this family. The parish is responsible for coordinating sacramental preparation and providing faith education for both adults and children.

Who is eligible to receive the Sacraments?

As first teachers in faith you as parents are in the best place to judge when your child is ready to participate in the sacramental life of the parish community. The following however may be a useful guide to assist you in this respect:

First Reconciliation:	Year 3 & above
First Holy Communion:	Year 4 & above
Confirmation:	Year 6 & above

If you or your children are not currently Catholic, but wishes to be involved in the sacramental life of the church, there is a separate process explained below:

RCIA: Rite of Christian Initiation for Adults

Have you thought about becoming a Catholic, would you like to explore this question more fully within our community? Then this process may be for you. It is designed for adults wishing to join the Catholic Faith and for adults who have not completed the sacraments of initiation (Confirmation and/or Eucharist).

RCIC: Rite of Christian Initiation for Children

Would you like your school aged child to be baptized and become part of our Catholic community? This process is for children of sacramental age who are not baptized.

First Step—Registration Process

Please complete a registration form if you wish your child to prepare for the sacraments in 2024/25. Please note: The children who receive First Reconciliation in 2024 will make First Holy Communion in 2025.

The registration form needs to be handed into the parish office together with copies of your child's Baptism certificate (for all sacraments) and First Holy Communion Certificate (for Confirmation). The forms need to be handed into the office or emailed to the parish office at varroville@dow.org.au. Online registration forms are available on our website: www.varroville.dow.org.au

The fee for each sacrament is \$25 and additional \$25 for each retreat day. The fee, which will assist in covering the cost of materials and the retreat day, is payable on registration (speak to the coordinators if you require alternative arrangements).
